IMPACT OF COVID-19 PANDEMIC

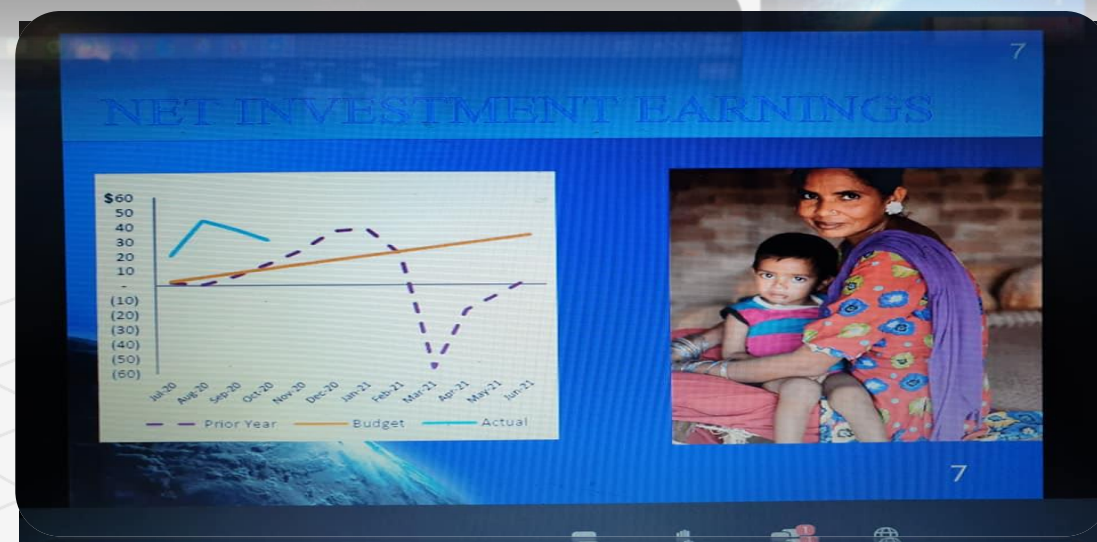
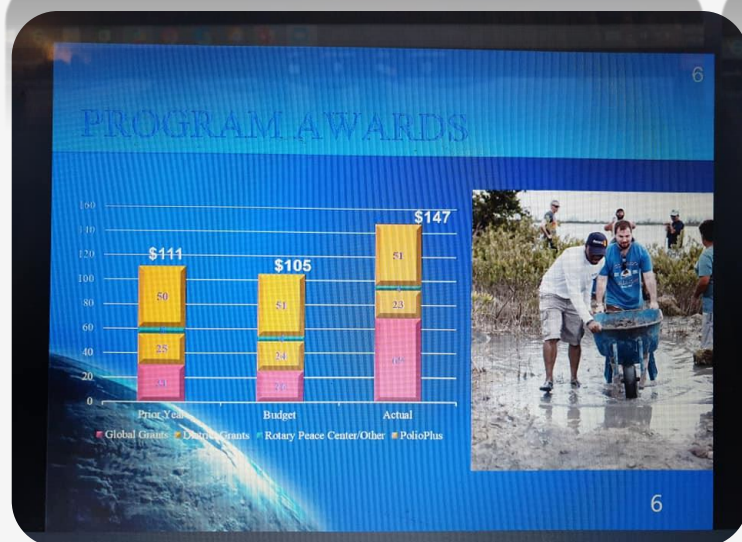
- Polio campaigns resumed in July after pause based on global guidance related to physical distancing.
- Number of vulnerable children increased.
- Potential wider spread of the virus.
- Possible impact on political and financial commitments to polio.

SUMMARY OF PROGRESS

- Nearly 19 million people are walking or alive due to immunization efforts.
- Polio cases reduced by more than 99%.
- Types 2 & 3 wild polio certified eradicated.
- Africa region certified polio-free.
- Only two countries are reporting wild poliovirus: Afghanistan and Pakistan.

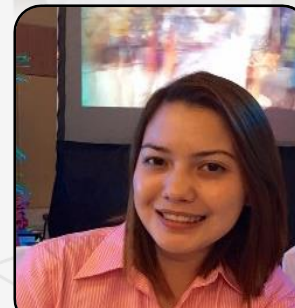

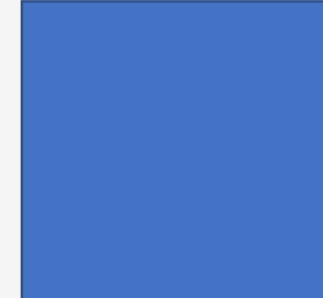
