


The President's Corner **Emmanuel "Noel" Villa-Abrille** Club President

# Our Guest of Honor & Speaker...

# Joaquin "Jack" Rodriguez President, RC Manila



Joaquin "Jack" Rodriguez, Sr. happens to not only be the "Champion President" of Rotary Club Manila but also serves for 16 years now as Consul to Serbia. It would take the whole meeting to speak of an endless list of extraordinary things about Jack, the business man vis a vis his being only a "2 year old Rotarian" now leading the 100 years celebration of the first Rotary club chartered in Asia and the Philippines.

Today what we want to specially highlight is something people hardly know about his Davao roots and ancestry. Jack is married to a Davao icon of beauty, talent and grace in the person of Sonja Habana, daughter of old Davao prestigious law practitioner, Atty. Antonio Habana Jr. the son of Capiz Congressman Antonio Sr. who was married to the first cousin of post-war President Manuel Rojas.

Jack on the other hand happens to be the paternal grandson and namesake of a Spanish lawyer Joaquin Serra Rodriguez who was appointed governor-at-large of Davao by Gen. John "Blackjack" Pershing who was the governor of the Moro Province before 1915 when the old Davao Province was officially created. A reminder of this period is Carmen, a village in Baguio District which was named after Rodriguez's wife.

Jack is father to 4 very successful boys in their own right and has 10 beautiful grandchildren with one named Katarina or Katja for short now the reigning Miss World.

Jack's curriculum vitae easily outshines anyone's resume because he has built impressive empires of companies including mining and oil even life insurance. He also is a restaurateur of several bistro groups with successful franchises like TGI Friday and Italiannis. As a Rotarian he is a member of the exclusive Arch Klump Society and although he does not really play politics, Jack went to the Netherlands to support the peace talks between the Philippine Government and the NPA.

Today however we will listen to a Rotary Champion President talk about an amazing program called TREES - The Rotary Economic and Ecological Strategem to celebrate the centennial of Manila Rotary. This milestone project educates our citizens on the importance of caring for our environment and ecology which our club is honored to be collaborating with because after all, Rotary Manila is our "grandmother club."
