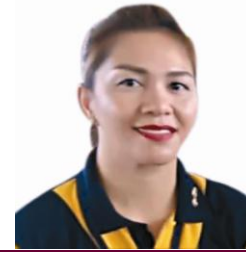

## *Our Guest of Honor & Speaker...*

**Joaquin "Jack" Rodriguez**  
*President, RC Manila*



Joaquin "Jack" Rodriguez, Sr. happens to not only be the "Champion President" of Rotary Club Manila but also serves for 16 years now as Consul to Serbia. It would take the whole meeting to speak of an endless list of extraordinary things about Jack, the business man *vis a vis* his being only a "2 year old Rotarian" now leading the 100 years celebration of the first Rotary club chartered in Asia and the Philippines.

Today what we want to specially highlight is something people hardly know about his Davao roots and ancestry.
