## *Our Guest of Honor & Speaker...*

**POLICE COLONEL KIRBY JOHN BRION KRAFT**  
*City Director, Davao City Police Office*

Today we are honored by the presence of a distinguished officer and a gentleman who is best described for his humility, brilliance and unquestionable integrity. He is known for his principle "Serbisyong Tama at May Malasakit".

Our Speaker was born in Calauan, Laguna on May 1, 1970. He finished Elementary Education at Liceo De Calauan and High School at Our Lady of Guadalupe Minor Seminary in Makati City. He earned units in Philosophy from San Carlos Seminary and Political Science from San Pablo Colleges. He graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Public Safety at the Philippine National Police Academy and belongs to SANDIGAN CLASS of 1994. He earned Master of Public Administration from the University of the Visayas in Cebu City.

He is married to the former Miss Annaly P Kho of Bacolod City and blessed with three lovely daughters namely Rafaella Beatriz, Kimberly Anne and Kiara Joan and only son Kirby John Bruno.

With a sterling public service record that is characterized primarily by utmost dedication sheer hard work and genuine accountability, he served various prominent assignments in his more than twenty five years of police service.

As a Junior Officer, he joined the PNP Special Action Force where he served as Intelligence Officer in Basilan, Sultan Kudarat and North Cotabato. He served as Platoon Leader, Operations Officer, Admin Officer, Training Officer and Executive Officer in the province of Negros Occidental. He was the Battalion Logistics Officer of the 3rd Special Action Battalion in Bataan and Zambales.

In 1998, he was assigned at the PNP National Headquarters, Camp Crame and served as the Deputy Chief of the Internal Security Operations Division of the Directorate for Operations and later transferred to the Directorate for Logistics as Admin Officer of the Director for Logistics.

In August 1998, he was reassigned in Zamboanga as Aide-de-Camp of the Regional Director of Police Regional Office 9 and Team Leader of the Regional Special Operations Group. He assumed as the Regional Chief of the Civil Security Unit in August 1999. On October 2002, he was reassigned in Cebu Region as Finance Officer in Bohol and Mandaue City and later in Negros Oriental.

In April 2008, he was transferred to CALABARZON and was assigned in Laguna Police as Chief of the Provincial Operations and Plans. He was designated as Group Director of the 405th Police Provincial Mobile Group on January 2009. Later, he became the first Commander of the Laguna Police Provincial Public Safety Company covering the whole Laguna Province wherein his unit was awarded the Best Provincial Public Safety Company in the whole CALABARZON for the Year 2009.

In April 2011, he was designated as Chief of Police of the San Pedro Municipal Police Station wherein it was adjudged as the Best Police Station Nationwide for 2011. He was among the Top 5 LEAD PNP Nationwide also in 2011. He was a recipient of the Bakas Parangal ng Kabayanihan from the NDRRMC (National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council) in 2012 at Camp Aguinaldo, Quezon City. He was also awarded the LAKAN Award by the PNPA Alumni Association for being an outstanding Alumni Police Officer for 2013.

In January 2013, he became the Chief of the Provincial Intelligence of Laguna Police wherein he was awarded as the Best Police Commissioned Officer in the field of Operation in the whole CALABARZON.

In July 2015, he served as the Chief of the Regional Personnel and Human Resource and Doctrine Development (R1) of Police Regional Office MIMAROPA in Mindoro and later become the Chief of the Regional Intelligence (R2) in January 2016.

In June 30, 2016, when President Rodrigo R Duterte assumed office, he was transferred back at the National Headquarters – PNP, Camp Crame, where he served as Senior Executive Assistant to The Chief of the Directorial Staff, then as Senior Executive Assistant to The Deputy Chief PNP for Operations Senior, after which as Senior Executive Assistant of The Deputy Chief PNP for Administration then Lt Gen Ramon C Apolinario. In early 2018 he became the Provincial

Director of Laguna Police and later the Regional Chief of the Highway Patrol Group in Region 3 wherein it was awarded the HPG Best Regional Highway Patrol Unit Nationwide for 2018.

He is a recipient of various medals and awards such as Medalya ng Kadakilaan, Medalya ng Papuri, Medalya ng Kasanayan, Medalya ng Kagalingan, Medalya ng Paglilingkod sa Luzon, Medalya ng Paglilingkod sa Visayas, Medalya ng Paglilingkod sa Mindanao, Medalya ng Paglaban sa Manliligalig, Medalya ng Pagtulong sa Nasalanta, Medalya ng Ugnayang Pampulisya, Medalya ng Paglilingkod, Military Merit Medal and several commendations from different sectors of the society.

Throughout his service, he has always placed a premium on continuing education as an important tool in enhancing his skills and expertise as a police officer and a leader, thus he took up the Public Safety Officer's Senior Executive Course at National Police College in 2014 and graduated number one in the class, the Investigation Officer's Basic Course at PNP Directorate for Investigation and Detective Management in 2013, the Police Intelligence Officer's Advance Course at PNP Intelligence Training Group in 2005 and Finance Officer's Basic Course at PNP Finance Center in 1997.
