The President's Corner

Emmanuel "Noel" Villa-Abrille Club President


Good Afternoon everyone,

Glad to see that everyone is in fit shape. A recap on last weeks discussion, the club unanimously voted that we use Gavagives as our platform to raise funds for our upcoming projects and PP Maeng chair the processing of our registration. It was also decided that PDG Nonoy chair the SEC Registration of RCSD and he gladly accepted. We were not able to discuss PE Inggys induction, hope we can do that today.

Last Saturday, May 16 @ 7:30 pm, our district had a town hall meeting, with Gov. Philip, DGE Riz, DGN Anna, DGND Lilo, a few district officers and the presidents of the different Rotary Clubs. I would like to share what was discussed:

- the Discon and Distas is officially cancelled. The District will instead create a coffee table book that will showcase the different clubs, awards and the talks of the quests. It would be worth P1,500.00, more or less and will be given out by August, hopefully. in lieu of discon (cancelled) to be released on August:
- For those who have already registered, the District will give a refund, less the P1.500.00 for the coffee table book:
- RI President Elect Robert Knaack did not create any citations for the coming Rotary Year, the President Elect must set their own goals at My Rotary;
- RI will not allow in person meetings for the next six months;
- With the current situation, there will no longer be a required minimum number of rotarians that must be present for turnover/implementation of projects:
- The deadline for submission of projects has been moved to June 30:
- As of Saturday, our District has contributed a total of \$714,683.00 to the TRF;
- Our District is the third highest polio contributor;
- A disaster fund worth \$25,000.00 has been approved for COVID-19 projects;
- For the Rotary Village in Magsaysay, Davao del Sur, a total of P3M has already been raised. P1M more to go to reach the targeted amount:
- The lot for the Rotary Village has already been purchased by the LGU, around 2.1 HAS and is around 75% ready:
- There is an ongoing negotiation regarding the cost of the house. The initial quote of P65k has been adjusted to P116k. If they come into an agreement, the first 10 houses will start construction by first week of June.

Inspite and despite every trial that has been thrown at everybody this year, let us continue to be optimistic and strive to survive these difficult times. Remember that when the door is closed, a window will open, in line with our theme for Rotary Year 2020-2021 "Rotary Opens Opportunities".

Rotary leadership, committees, RI secretariat

The RI Board, in response to the global COVID-19 pandemic, agreed to general principles at their April meeting. Here are some of the highlights:

- The health and safety of all participants in Rotary programs, meetings, and events is of paramount importance.
- No in-person meeting or event shall be mandatory for any Rotary participant who may feel uncomfortable attending because of the pandemic.
- All conveners and organizers of Rotary meetings are strongly encouraged to consider all health concerns in deciding whether to hold in-person meetings.
- All RI Board meetings shall be conducted virtually (and not in-person) for the remainder of calendar year 2020
- · All RI committee meetings shall be conducted virtually (and not inperson) for the remainder of calendar year 2020
- 2020 Rotary Institute conveners are authorized to decide whether to conduct their institutes and governor-elect and governor-nominee training in-person or virtually
- RI shall not fund the expenses of any president's representative to a district conference for the 2020–21 Rotary year. If a district requests a president's representative, the president may appoint one from the same region of the world in which the district is located, at no cost to RI.
- Governors are strongly encouraged to use virtual meetings for club visits that occur during calendar year 2020
- Regional leaders are strongly encouraged to use virtual meetings for training seminars and other events during calendar year 2020

All RI staff travel, both international and domestic, has also been canceled through 31 May. RI staff at Evanston headquarters and all of Rotary's global offices are practicing social distancing by working from home until least 31 May.


