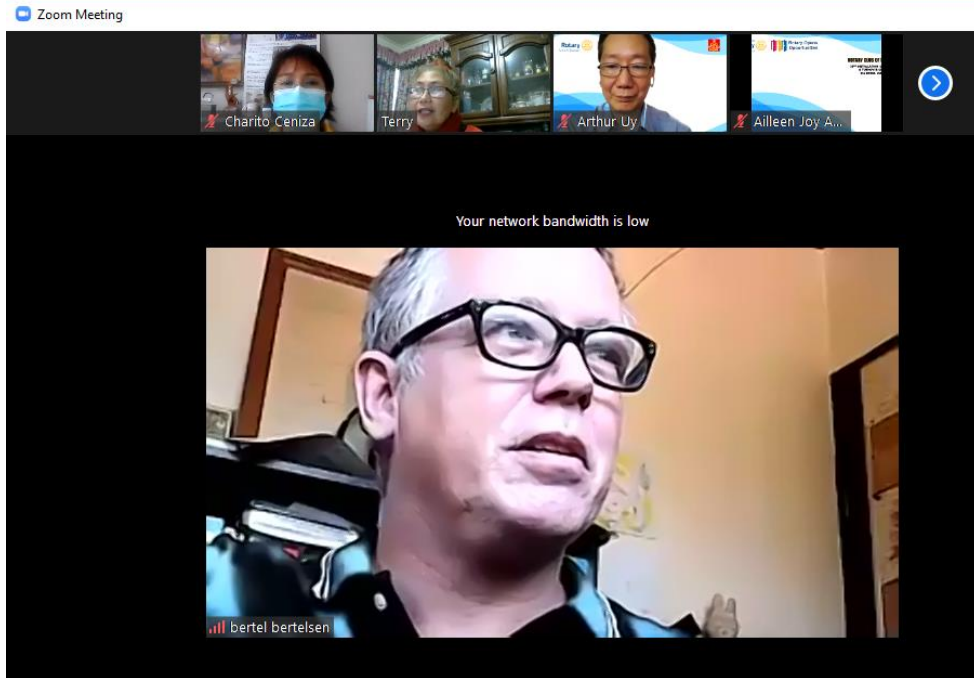
My dear Fellow Rotarians,
