# Ms. LOHWANA HALAQ

# Lohwana Halaq is a

Canadian-Filipino Primatologist from the University of Calgary, whose passion for animals has led her on travels around the world. Her fieldwork studies began in the forests of Belize in Central America. Collecting behavioral data on howler monkeys solidified her passion in wildlife conservation, inspiring her to continue her journey abroad with the Philippine Eagle Foundation. Ultimately, this life changing experience led her to permanently emigrate to the Philippines to work with the Captive Breeding Department as Animal keeper, Breeder and Eagle Trainer for the Philippine Eagles and other birds of prey. She has successfully incubated, hatched, and chick reared the endangered Philippine Pinkser's Hawk-eagle and trained numerous other raptors. Besides birds of prey, she is also the Primate Keeper for the PEC's troop of long tailed macaques. Among her accomplishments, Lohwana is the first woman in history to flight train the Great Philippine Eagle and bring to fruition the Raptors in Flight demonstration aimed to educate visitors and the public about Philippine Eagle conservation.
