Myanmar refugees charter new club in Indiana

I began to work with the nonprofit organization Chin Community of Indiana in 2016 after our club's foundation granted them \$250,000 over five years, with a three-year extension through 2023. Many Burmese Chin, fleeing persecution in their home country, have chosen Southport as their new home. Almost 20,000 Chin live on the south side of Indianapolis, [making it one of the largest concentrations of Chin people outside of Myanmar](#).

I was asked to be the liaison to the Chin organization and one of the first things I did was to create a Chin Support Committee. This committee meets quarterly to determine what type of additional assistance the Chin residents need. All along, I have worked closely with their leadership. It was decided a couple of years ago that starting a Satellite Club of Chins and non-Chins would help them assimilate into the greater Indianapolis community.

The satellite club meets at The Chin Center, which is the heart and soul of the Chin community. It took some time but in the fall of 2020, they had 22 members and applied to receive a charter to be their own Rotary club. Importantly, the president of this new club, Southport International, is a Chin. Though I'm a member of the Rotary Club of Indianapolis, the host club, I attend most of their meetings, whether in-person or via Zoom.

The Chin club members take great pride in telling people that they are Rotarians. They will hold a Charter Night as soon as all of us are able to meet in-person once again. The Executive Director of the Chin Community of Indiana, is a member. I have done some volunteering at the Chin Center to help them with questions that their five-person staff aren't able to answer.

When I talk about the Chin community, I find myself saying "we", because I have developed a deep relationship with the Chins, who are honest, hard-working, and very grateful to be able to live in the Indianapolis area.

Six months or so ago, I was asked to be a member of their Board of Directors, which includes five others, who are all Chin leaders in the community. As Rotary continues to create innovate new clubs, hopefully clubs will reach out to invite those who are from different countries. While there may be a language/cultural barrier at first, with patience, those barriers can be minimized and Rotary's reach in the U.S. can expand greatly.



1. On the Year Book:

2. On the Parade of Clubs

During the Opening ceremonies, it is customary to honor each Club with the Parade. On the virtual platform, we will create an Audio-Video Presentation (AVP) to achieve this. The same Items/pictures for the yearbook will be used for the DISCON Parade of clubs AVP, so give us the best.

Club President: Please send us a 5 to 10 second video of you (optional: and your spouse in the picture) greeting the Discon participants in your own native dialect. Pick a background that will tell/show the world where you are from (ex: The Magellan Shrine to show that you are from Cebu, etc). Please send us a "symbol"/Logo that represent your area example: Davao = Eagle. After we show your club's credentials, we will show the world where your club is located in the District Map (using the "symbol").

3. On the "Island"

- a. The concept for the DISCON is similar to that of an Archipelago. Though we are separated geographically, we will come together as One District.
- b. To make this happen during the convention period of 4-6 June, we encourage you to organize your own gathering (following strictly safety and health protocols mandated by the LGU). Pick a venue convenient for ALL to gather safely to hook-up/view/connect into the convention goings-on.

- c. In your venue ("island"), please set-up a link to the DISCON. The idea is for your members to gather and be part of the activities. Maybe a Large Monitor/screen and a computer connected to the internet.
- d. During some of the activities, like the fellowship, we will put the "spotlight" on your club and flash it on screen for the rest of the district to see (when we do this, please make as much noise as possible).
- e. The "island" is a chance to fellowship.

4. For the fellowship night

- a. We encourage you to gather as many of your members as can be permitted.
- b. Connect to the DISCON (Audio & Video). And be ready to be "Spotlighted"
- c. Your Club's Participation- Initial Plan:
 - c.1 Please send us a Tiktok presentation. (Mechanics to follow)
 - c.2 It must have at least 3 Rotarians participating.
 - c.3 No more than 2 Minutes long.
- d. Top 10 winners will be shown during the fellowship night. Other submissions will be shown during the course of the convention (in-between activities).

5. Pre-Convention Events

- a. Sports events: we are looking at Golf, Cycling, and Running. The Sports Committee will be sending you the mechanics soon.
- b. Resolutions - the council of Governors are to release mechanics, standby.
- c. Distribution of Awards from the District. Major Awards will be given out during the 3rd day of the DISCON.

6. Club Video/Presentation of Service Projects

Will appreciate receiving your one-minute video presentation of your major community service projects on or before April 30, 2021 especially on the global grants projects. We will be presenting/showing this between activities and it will also be used by Gov. Riz during his presentation.

7. Plenary Sessions

- a. We've allotted the 2nd day for our Plenary Sessions. We have invited some speakers to share with us their take on "Opening Opportunities to a Whole New World".
- b. At the end of each session is a Question and Answer section. We encourage you and your members to participate. Mechanics to follow.

8. Solicitations

- a. All Clubs / areas are encouraged to set-up the "island". As such, please expect that there will be some expenses that the club might incur. So Clubs/Areas/Zones are encouraged to raise their own funds.
- b. The Mechanics will be as follows:
 - b1. Clubs submits their list of potential donors with respective email address to the Discon Committee;
 - b2. The Discon Committee sends the solicitation letter to the donor copy furnish the nominating club;

- b3. The nominating club follow-up the collection of donation and remits the amount net of the club's share as indicated in item c herein;
- b4. The Club then sends the Solicitation/Donation contract to the Discon Committee for inclusion/acknowledgement as indicated in the contract.

- c. Revenue earned from Solicitation shall be distributed:
 - 25% shall go to the soliciting Rotarian's club
 - 25% shall go to the soliciting club's TRF Fund
 - 50% shall go to the Discon Fund
