SECRETARY'S MESSAGE Sec. Mark Esperancilla

"The Tipping Point" a book by Malcolm Gladwell talks about how an epidemic, a shoe brand, a children's show and how trends achieve the boiling point or the moment

of critical mass which translates into overwhelming reach. He theorizes the three agents of change: The Law of the Few, The Stickiness Factor, and The Power of Context.

The Law of the Few simply states that "The success of any kind of social epidemic is heavily dependent on the involvement of people with a particular and rare set of social gifts." He categorizes them into three groups:


- Connectors are the people in a community who know large numbers of people and who are in the habit of making introductions. A connector is essentially the social equivalent of a computer network hub. They usually know people across an array of social, cultural, professional, and economic circles, and make a habit of introducing people who work or live-in different circles. They are people who "link us up with the world...people with a special gift for bringing the world together."
- Mavens are "information specialists", or "people we rely upon to connect us with new information." They accumulate knowledge, especially about the marketplace, and know how to share it with others. Gladwell cites author Mark Alpert as a prototypical Maven who is "almost pathologically helpful", further adding, "he can't help himself." In this vein, Alpert himself concedes, "A Maven is someone who wants to solve other people's problems, generally by solving his own."According to Gladwell, Mavens start "word-of-mouth" epidemics" due to their knowledge, social skills, and ability to communicate. As Gladwell states: "Mavens are really information brokers, sharing and trading what they know."
- <u>Salesmen</u> are "persuaders", charismatic people with powerful negotiation skills. They tend to have an indefinable trait that goes beyond what they say, which makes others want to agree with them.

As Rotarians we called upon to bring about change by using our unique set of skills we have learned and mastered in our personal businesses and professions. This year we are challenge by our no less than our Rotary International President Shekhar Mehta to "Each One, Bring One". Let us invite prospect Rotarians from different backgrounds and unique fields to improve our diversity and increase our impact by bringing in experts in their profession. This would ensure that this year we can expand our reach to farflung communities to which we haven't be able to reach. Let us invite Connectors to help secure projects with greater influence, let us invite Mavens who would willingly share their expertise so we are able to come up with fresh ideas to evolve into service projects and let's bring in Salesmen to further our bond thru fellowship and friendship.

This year with inspired Rotarians ready to serve and change lives, can be o<mark>ur Tipping Point and make a long-lasting impact in our community.</mark>

Rotary 2022 International Convention to be held in Houston

The event will bring more than 20,000 participants from around the world and deliver \$30 million in local economic impact



HOUSTON (July 22, 2021) – During a joint news conference held at George R. Brown Convention Center today, Rotary and Houston First Corporation representatives announced that more than 20,000 service-minded people from around the world will gather in Houston for Rotary's 113th annual international convention on June 4-8, 2022.

The coveted international event is returning to Houston for the third time, marking the 50th anniversary of the 1972 international convention. The Bayou City also hosted the 5th Rotary convention in 1914. The event is expected to deliver S30 million in economic impact for the city's hotels, restaurants, retailers and attractions.

"As a global membership organization that brings people from all continents and cultures together to share, learn and take action to bring positive and lasting change to communities around the world, we are thrilled that our first in-person international convention since 2019 will take place in Houston," said Rotary's International President Shekhar Mehta. "And for the first time ever, our annual event will be open to members of the public who want to connect, learn and be a part of our work to grow and change lives."

Rotary's 2022 international convention will transform the George R. Brown Convention Center into an energized hub and cultural mosaic as the organization's global network of volunteers gather to share information about all the ways they are taking action to address issues in their communities, to learn from notable experts, gain inspiration from world-class speakers, and connect with lifelong friends shaped through service.

Previous convention speakers include philanthropist Bill Gates; actor and philanthropist Ashton Kutcher; Prime Minister Justin Trudeau; actor, producer, host, entrepreneur, WWE Superstar and Rotary polio ambassador, John Cena; renowned primatologist Jane Goodall; and former United States Ambassador to the United Nations, Andrew Young.

Organized by Rotary International in conjunction with the Houston Host Organization Committee of local Rotary members, registrants of the convention will also experience Houston's hospitality with visits to local destinations like Space Center Houston, Kemah Boardwalk and one of Houston's premiere shopping destinations, The Galleria.

"Houston and Houston First Corporation are thrilled to host Rotary's International Convention next summer," said Jorge Franz, Senior Vice President Tourism and Industry Relations at Houston First Corporation & Greater Houston Convention & Visitors Bureau's president. "We look forward to welcoming the thousands of awesome Rotary

members who through their volunteerism and commitment to problem-solving make our communities better from continent to continent. This global exposure to 1.2 million Rotarians worldwide will further elevate Houston as a travel destination, and the anticipated S30 million economic impact from the convention will be a financial shot in the arm for Houston hotels, restaurants, retailers, attractions and many more."

Houston Host Organization Committee chair, Rhonda Kennedy, representing 62 Houston-area clubs and its 2,400 members, said, "as a proud member of the Rotary Club of Sweeny, I am excited not only to welcome our fellow members from around the world to our beloved city, but also to show how Houston-area clubs are taking action to make the world a better place at home and abroad."

With the safety and wellbeing of participants and the wider community a top priority, Rotary's previous two conventions were held virtually due to the global pandemic. Speaking during the press conference, John Smarge, chair of Rotary's International Convention Committee, said, "this convention will also have a virtual component to make the event accessible to all members. And as we continue our planning, we will work closely with global and national health authorities to ensure that our in-person event follows the most current health and safety guidelines."

Mr. Ericson Feliciano S. Alarcon
OIC, Phil. Red Cross-Leyte Chapter



I am a regular staff of the Philippine Red Cross – having a position of Chapter Officer in Charge. I am originally employed as CSR in the southern part of the Philippines in the Sulu Islands. My extensive experience in armed conflicts and other situations of violence, while working in tandem with ICRC, gave me an opportunity to further boost my related experiences managing situations and volunteers on a larger disaster scope, when I was called to serve as Team Leader in the Samar Islands here in Visayas.

The Samar engagement is the start of my Haiyan, Early to Post Recovery operations. I worked with various partner National Societies at that time, even assigned to Panay Island in Iloilo. Until now, I am still blessed to be engaged in this role here in Leyte, especially seeing the potential of the chapter to see better days ahead by strengthening local collaboration and resource mobilization with stakeholders thereby expanding our reach and be readily able to cater to those vulnerable groups of people, in terms of humanitarian services.

Partners like ICRC, Norwegian Red Cross, Spanish Red Cross, Finnish Red Cross, German Red Cross, Australian Red Cross, British Red Cross, Korean Red Cross and the American Red Cross, where I extensively shared and learned experiences with, in management and development. I even got a short stint of this management post in the Marawi Siege Crisis recovery in Iligan City and Lanao del Sur in Mindanao. Accomplishments include: Project closures and turn-overs in Western Samar, Eastern Samar, Iloilo, Leyte with the Australian and just recently, a program supported by the American Red Cross.

Now, we are focused on capacitating chapters and sustaining community initiatives given earlier during the Recovery Programs of Haiyan. It is also a welcoming site and a new leaf of challenges while I'm now back at the chapter operations. The elusive dream of bringing the organization closer to the people will soon be realized. Philippine Red Cross – Leyte Chapter: Leyteños partner of Choice.

It is so gratifying to have worked with so many talented, dedicated and strong personnel, with various competencies, forming the ideal team to finish every job. The story continues...
