The honorable president was merely articulating his empathy to the affected families whose loved one's dead bodies were never been recovered or found. 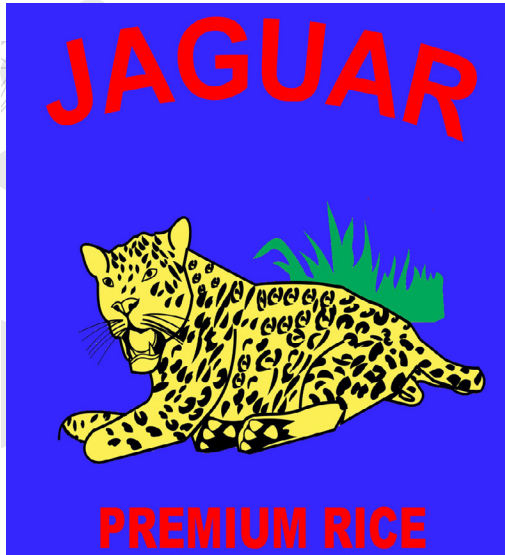

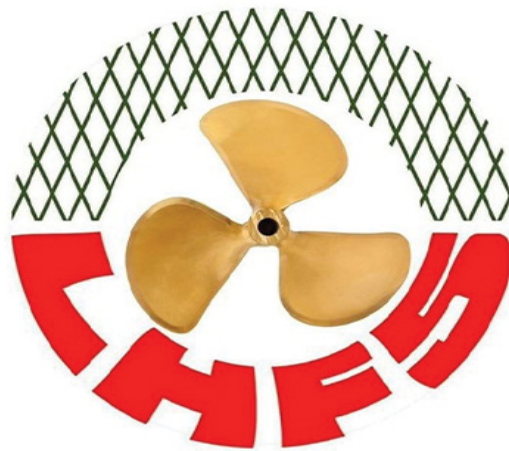
