

This is just a reminder that our mangrove planting activity is set for this Saturday, August 2, in Abuyog, Leyte. We'll meet at 7:00 AM at the Rotary Center so we can travel together. Carpooling will make the trip easier and give us a chance to catch up on the way.

Mangrove planting plays an important role in protecting our coastal communities. They act as natural barriers against erosion and storm surges, and they support marine life by improving the health of coastal ecosystems. As part of Rotary Areas 3B and 3C, we'll be joining the Rotary Club of Leyte Gulf and partner agencies such as the Local Government Unit of Abuyog -Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (LGU Abuyog - MENRO), the Philippine Army (PA), the Philippine National Police (PNP), the Bureau of Corrections (BUCOR), and the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP). It's a good opportunity to build connections while doing something that has a real, longterm benefit.


Dear Fellow Rotarians,


