Mangrove planting plays an important role in protecting our coastal communities. They act as natural barriers against erosion and storm surges, and they support marine life by improving the health of coastal ecosystems. 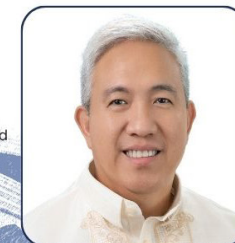
