

On July 31, PAG Joel Caminade and PP Bobby Andrade represented our club at the Induction Ceremony of the Rotary Club of Bagumbayan Manila. Strengthening ties with our partner clubs helps open doors for future collaboration. Their presence at the event was a simple but important way of continuing the goodwill we've built through shared service over the years.

A few days later, on August 2, we joined a mangrove planting activity in Abuyog, Leyte. Pres. Jude Duarte, along with members of Rotaract SLSU and Rotaract Tacloban, took part in this coastal initiative organized by Rotary Clubs in Areas 3B and 3C. Mangroves act as natural buffers against waves and erosion. They give fish habitats and improve shoreline resilience. With the tsunami advisory issued earlier on July 30 by PHIVOLCS, advising coastal communities in Leyte and beyond to move inland and suspend water activities, the planting took on added significance. Those warnings were later canceled after sea-level monitoring showed no major wave activity.

The event was done in partnership with the Rotary Club of Leyte Gulf and supported by agencies including LGU Abuyog–MENRO, the Philippine Army, PNP, BUCOR, and BFP. It's good to see these kinds of coordinated efforts where each group contributes in their own way.

We've had a busy month and many of you have been part of it. Your participation and support made July productive. Let's use that energy as we head into August.
