Dear Fellow Rotarians,

Greetings in service!

September is Basic Education and Literacy Month, and our club is taking the lead with a project designed to bring learning closer to children. We are preparing Once Upon a Step – A Story-Dance Literacy Workshop for the pupils of Manlurip Elementary School.

For the pilot run, the story An Suok na Magsangkay (“Best Friends”) will be used. Written in Waray-Waray for Grade 2, it is part of the Health curriculum and teaches values of friendship, integrity, and community. Using the local language matches the direction of the Matatag Curriculum, where early learning is grounded in the mother tongue. This approach makes lessons clearer and gives children a stronger base for reading and comprehension.

The workshop is built around two sessions: a dance workshop, followed by a presentation and reflection. It connects storytelling with movement to give children different ways to engage with literacy. We all know that learners absorb lessons differently. Some respond best to hearing a story, others to visuals or actions, and many benefit when these elements are combined. The sessions will be held on September 18 and September 30, 2025.

Beyond this, we are also preparing for an important milestone in our Rotary calendar. On October 4, our District Governor will visit our club. His presence gives us the opportunity to share the work we've been doing, including projects like the literacy workshop, and to affirm our commitment to Rotary's priorities. The Governor's Visit gives us the chance to spend time together as a club, to share thoughts, learn from one another, and look ahead to what's next. Everyone's presence matters, and it will help make the day feel truly welcoming. Our preparations are in motion, and we're excited to receive him with the same sense of unity that has always guided our work.

Our Regular Meeting today builds on the good work already happening in the club. This week, we welcome a guest speaker from Globe Philippines, a recognized authority in mangrove and environmental conservation with a double master's degree from Ateneo de Manila University and the University of Melbourne. If you want to find out who he is and gain insight into conservation that matters to our community, make sure you're there. Important club updates and upcoming projects will also be discussed, and your presence will help move our plans forward.

We have projects moving forward, the Governor's Visit is just around the corner, and meaningful conversations are happening in our meetings. September and October will keep us active in the best way, and I'm grateful for the time and energy each of you brings to our club.

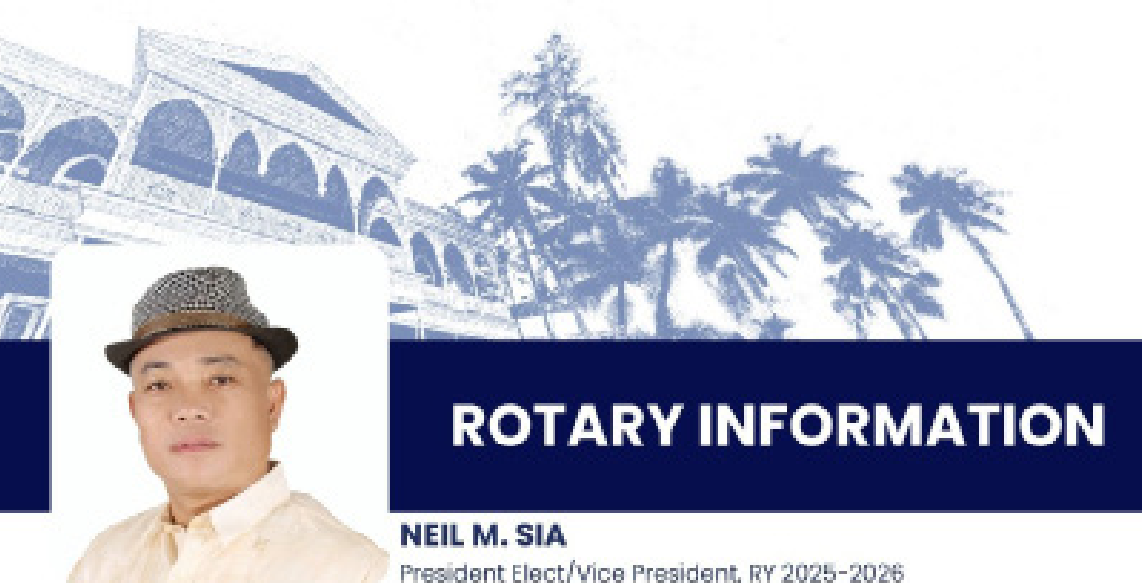

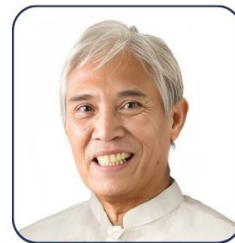

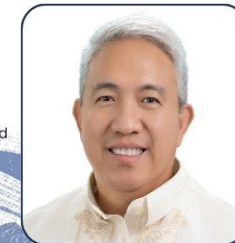
