DISTRICT GOVERNOR'S MESSAGE

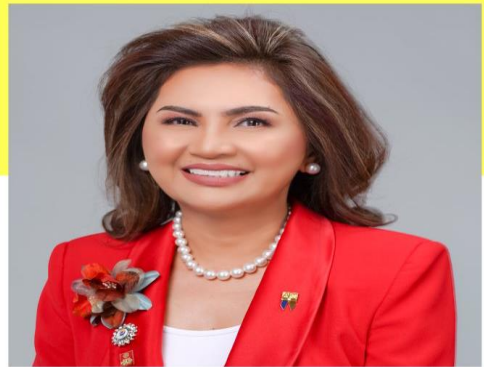
My dear fellow Rotarians,

We begin the month of October with our advocacy on breast cancer awareness since this month is celebrated as International Breast Cancer Awareness Month dubbed as Pink October. I am so impressed with the ways the clubs commemorate it, and I am delighted to share with you that the City of Davao and the City of Dumaguete have already passed and approved a Resolution that starting this year and every year of every October, both cities will celebrate and support the campaign for Breast Cancer Awareness Program of Rotary.

I would also like to recognize and express my great appreciation for your fund-raising activities to raise funds to eradicate polio, but don't you forget that in Rotary it is also Economic and Community Development Month. It is one of the seven Areas of Focus that Rotary has asked all clubs to focus on this month of October.

Over the years, Rotarians have struggled hard to empower their communities. Every community has unique needs and concerns, and Rotary has countless ways to address them. One is to explore livelihood skills training opportunities for members of the community. Another is to improve their access to financial services by partnering with a local micro-lending organization in the locality and providing financial infrastructure in the community, including a job placement program.

In many developing countries, we see increased poverty, especially after the Covid-19 pandemic. Most of these deprived of livelihood are found in the rural areas.



As Rotarians, we are in an ideal position to help them recover what they lost during the pandemic. Aside from creating livelihood skills training, you may opt to sponsor a person's career through an apprenticeship in your own business or through connections to other business or service organizations. Dole-outs are discouraged since we don't want short-lived means of empowering people; we give them means that will sustain them through the years. That is economics, offering opportunities for people to be resources to their communities through networking activities. To develop community leaders that will help strengthen local entrepreneurs and help them establish their own small-scale businesses.

Rotarians should lead in developing communities through their various community service projects. Together, we empower them. Together, we give them hope, the best way to fulfill Rotary's motto of Service Above Self.

5 LOW- GLYCEMIC INDEX FRUITS



Cherries

Loaded with vitamin C, polyphenol, tryptophan, serotonin and melatonin cherries, stimulate insulin secretion.



Oranges

Ample amounts of vitamins A, C, antioxidants and low in GI, oranges help in regulating blood sugar spikes.



Apples

Apples, high on fibre and low in calories and glycaemic index help control hunger pangs.



Avocado

High on monounsaturated fatty acid and low on carbohydrates and sugar, avocados prevent spike in blood sugar.



Apricots

Vitamins A, C, potassium, copper and magnesium in apricots satisfy sweet cravings and regulate blood sugar levels.
