The day started with five members of LACES heading to Barangay Concepcion, Asuncion, Davao Del Norte to deliver materials for fence construction in the Patubig sa Humayan Project last June 20, 2019.

The Patubig sa Humayan Project was launched in the Rotary Year 2016- 2017 during the leadership of Past President Mary Ann M. Bantayan. The irrigation project provides water for rice fields nearby covering an area of at least eight hectares. With a durable waterpump, the community of farmers in the vicinity enjoys ample supply of water regardless of the climate and season of the year. Also provided therein is a jetmatic pump for potable water and for hygiene purposes.

The recent visit to the area is purposely to check the facility and get in touch with the recipients of the said project. Because of the intent to make the said project long lasting, the Rotary Club of Tagum Golden LACES will fence the area to secure the water pump and to make a concrete flooring surrounding the jetmatic pump.

Among the goals of the said project is to end poverty and promote protecting the environment and addressing climate change which is one of the Sustainable Development Goals introduced by the United Nations in 2015. Rotarians are committed to reaching this goal through projects like building wells, installing rainwater harvesting systems, and teaching community members maintain new infrastructure.

Thanks to our very loyal friend whom I will call "Carry Bow". "Carry Bow" is from Purok 1 Concepcion, Asuncion. Without it we could not transport the concrete posts and cement bags to the area Bow kami sayo, Carry!

## Women in Rotary

From 1905 until the 1980s, women were not allowed membership in Rotary Clubs, although Rotarian spouses, including Paul Harris' wife, were often members of the similar "Inner Wheel" Club. Women did play some roles, and Paul Harris' wife made numerous speeches. In 1963, it was noted that the Rotary practice of involving wives in club activities had helped to break down female seclusion in some countries. Clubs such as Rotary had long been pre-dated by women's voluntary organizations, which started in the United States as early as 1790.

The first Irish Clubs discussed admitting women as members in 1912, but the proposal floundered over issues of social class.

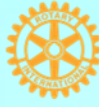
Gender equity in Rotary moved beyond the theoretical question when, in 1976, the Rotary Club of Duarte in Duarte, California admitted three women as members. After this club refused to remove the women from membership, in 1978 Rotary International revoked the Club's charter. The Duarte Club filed suit in the California courts, claiming that Rotary Clubs are business establishments subject to regulation under California's Unruh Civil Rights Act, which bans discrimination based on race, gender, religion or ethnic origin. Rotary International then appealed the decision to the U.S. Supreme Court. The RI attorney argued that "... [the decision] threatens to force us to take in everyone, "like a motel." The Duarte Club was not alone in opposing RI leadership; the Seattle-International District Club unanimously voted to admit women in 1986. The United States Supreme Court, on May 4, 1987, confirmed the Californian decision. Rotary International then removed the gender requirements from its requirements for club charters, and most clubs in most countries have opted to include women as members of Rotary Clubs. The first female club president to be elected was Silvia Whitlock of the Rotary Club of Duarte, California, USA in 1987. By 2007, there was a female trustee of Rotary's charitable wing, The Rotary Foundation, while female district governors and club presidents were common. Women currently account for 15% of international Rotary membership (22% in North America). The change of the second Rotarian motto in 2004, from "He profits most who serves best" to "They profit most who serve best", 99 years after its foundation, illustrates the move to general acceptance of women members in Rotary.



## Makeups Attendance

Absences from regular club meetings may be made up in various ways listed in the Standard Rotary Club Constitution. Members who attend an RI meeting, such as a district conference, can credit the days attended to make up for club meetings missed as a result of attending the RI meeting. There several other ways as well. To achieve Rotary International's regulation of maintaining a minimum 60 percent attendance record, up to half of this requirement can be achieved by making up missed meetings:

- At other regularly established Rotary Club meetings including e-clubs or online clubs.
- At a District Assembly or Conference.
- At a Rotary International Convention or Conference.

## ROTARY CLUB OF TAGUM GOLDEN LACES HISTORY

The idea of organizing an all-female Rotary Club of Tagum was thought of as early as 1989 by the Rotarian and Anns of RC Tagum North. The initial organizing of the club however started only sometime in the first week of February 1991.

Rey Vegara, Incumbent President RC Tagum North, Rtn. Bebot Madayag, District Governor's Representative & PP of RC Tagum. Other Rotarians who helped in giving various information included Rtn. Arrel Olaño, PP RC Tagum; Rtn. Danny Lee, Past DGR and PP of RC Tagum North; Rtn. Jun Cagas and Rtn. Raffy Erfe, both RC Tagum North.

Out of the original forty (40) ladies who were invited to organizational meetings, only 25 were finally submitted for charter membership of the new club. Agnes Resurreccion, Dir.; Rtn. Marilyn Grace Mangilet, Dir.; and Rtn. Arisfina Torre, Dir.

The club officers & members of the newly organized ROTARY CLUB OF TAGUM GOLDEN L.A.C.E.S. (Ladies in Action Committed to Effective Service) first met DG Xavier C. Ledesma, Incumbent District Governor for 1991-1992, at Molave Hotel on Sept. 4, 1992 in his club visitation of the Rotary Clubs in Tagum.

On December 1, 1992, the club received the good news from SEABO that its application for membership was formally admitted by Rotary International on November 19, 1992 with Club No. 29117.
