

Remembering M. A. T Caparas

A lawyer by profession, the first and only Filipino President of Rotary International, an entrepreneur, corporate lawyer, a visionary, humanist and a steadfast supporter of women in Rotary all wrapped in one "The Best of Humanity"; that was M.A.T Caparas.

His passion to serve became manifest with his deeply rooted respect for human dignity and his unwavering faith in the interest goodness of mankind.

Popularly known for being a visionary, he sees what is enstored for Rotary.

During his term four (4) major significant changes took place in the organiza-

tion.

### Polio Plus Launching

Foremost, was Polio Plus Launching which began in Rotary Year 1986-1987 which was met with skepticism particularly on the ability to raise so huge sum of money to fund the drive. However with all optimism and relentless effort, despite numerous challenges, the launching became a significant opening move for the eventual eradication of polio.

One Rotary Center

One Rotary Center was his second achievement. The little building getting crowded for a fast growing organization has metamorphosed to an 18-storey building which houses Rotary's entire home staff with a first class boardroom adjacent to a 190-seat auditorium. This edifice earns millions of dollars a year in rentals on unused floors.

Rotary Community Corps

M.A.T Caparas espoused the empowerment of communities through Rotary Village Corps which later became Rotary Community Corps, a team of men and women who are not Rotarians but works in partnership with Rotary Clubs to improve their communities. Rotary Community Corps, being Caparas brainchild mushroomed in 93 countries with 9,000 RCCs and 200, 000 empowered members.

4. Admission of Women

The most dramatic and remarkable thing that happened in Rotary which calls for a celebration was the admission of women to its membership. Termination of "men only" requirement paved the way to a vibrant, proactive, enthusiastic and empowered Rotary Clubs

Were if not for the women members, many clubs of old men would have ceased to exist.

More meaningful projects were brought to the fore by women Rotarians, who, with the passing of time showed great potentials for election to leadership positions in the Rotary Club

Emergence of women as club presidents, district governors and recently, the nomination of the first lady Rotary International President-Nominee, Jennifer E. Jones have widened the avenues of women's participation in unlifting human life and dignity.

In this time of pandemic, we avoid crowded places and large gatherings. That is the most prudent way to avoid the dreaded virus. However, this should not stop us from doing what we can do within our means. Last October 17, 2020, we made it a one-time activity: turn over of trashbins, BOD meeting, and river clean up. It started early in the morning and ended just 2 hours before lunch time. For us ladies, Saturday is a day we still devote to work and family but here in LACES, we also include club and service to others.

Service and fellowship are two core principles in Rotary. We continue to serve and at the same time we carry on implementing projects that give us time to unwind. Preoccupied as we are, we remain committed and devoted to the areas of focus of Rotary. For the first time in our club, we have implemented a project on the new area of focus which is environmental protection. May this small project of ours be set as a seed that will grow into a fruitful and lasting endeavor that will benefit more of the community. Thank you fellow Rotarians for your continuing support!



### **RI President Holger Knaack's Message**

During a recent Zoom meeting with Rotarians and Rotaractors, I looked at the smiling faces on my screen and realized how much our organization has changed in a short period. It is clear that there is no going back to the "old normal" in Rotary — and I see that as an exciting opportunity!

Innovation and change are happening at so many levels as we rethink and remake Rotary. Rotary's new flexibility is blending with digital culture to drive change in ways that many of us have never seen before. We can learn a lot from Rotarians like Rebecca Fry — who, at age 31, already has 15 years of Rotary experience.

I see Rotary as a phenomenal platform to change the world. I believe I can have the greatest influence by empowering others to create the change they wish to see in the world. I've gained leadership insights through my experiences in RYLA and Rotaract, and now, as charter president of the Rotary Social Impact Network, a new e-club.

Engaging Rotary program alumni is key in forming new clubs. Our club is proof that Rotaractors and other alumni want to join Rotary — but sometimes they can't find the Rotary club that's right for them. Our club has 31 members, all between the ages of 23 and 41, and almost all of them are alumni of Rotary programs.

We need to be able to integrate and align Rotary with the other personal and professional goals we're pursuing. In chartering this club, we set out to design a personalized model of Rotary that is focused on added value for our members. We have also sought to leverage connections — through Rotary Fellowships, Rotary Action Groups, and other international partnerships — in order to elevate our members' experiences beyond the club.

Our club meets and manages most of its projects online, using Microsoft Teams to engage 24/7 in topics that interest our members. This also means our club is not geographically bound to any one location: Although many of us are in Australia, we also have members in Germany, Italy, Mexico, Tanzania, and the United States.

Also key for our club is measuring the impact of our projects. For Plastic Free July this year, we created an awareness campaign promoting ways that individuals could reduce their use of plastics, and we reached more than 6,000 people. It's a project with a tangible impact that anyone can take part in wherever they are. I'm proud that, through our club, we are bringing people together for a new type of Rotary experience. I am excited for our future.

All Rotary clubs have the opportunity to be innovative clubs, just like Bec's club. Let's trust those clubs, learn from them, and lend them our support. Change in Rotary happens at the grassroots level, as clubs lead the charge, defining what this new Rotary can be.

Change is constant, and we have more work to do in many areas. It is important that we celebrate the contributions of people of all backgrounds and promote people from underrepresented groups so that they have greater opportunities to participate as members and leaders in Rotary.

The tools to make Rotary more inclusive, more relevant, and more fun for everyone are at our fingertips. Let's use them now, and we will see how *Rotary Opens Opportunities* for ourselves and for those yet to discover us.



### **ROTARY CLUB OF TAGUM GOLDEN LACES HISTORY**

The idea of organizing an all-female Rotary Club of Tagum was thought of as early as 1989 by the Rotarian and Anns of RC Tagum North. The initial organizing of the club however started only sometime in the first week of February 1991.

The names of 28 selected ladies were first floated by the Rotarians & Anns of RC Tagum North. Out of this number, 16 responded by attending the first organizational meeting held at Magnolia Kiosk along Quezon St., Tagum. Other ladies were later invited to the regular weekly meetings as prospective members of the club although their attendance along with some of those who were initially invited were irregular. In this organizational meetings, Rotary Information was given by Rtn. Jess Albacite, Special Governor's Representative and PP of RC Tagum North, Rtn. Rey Vegara, Incumbent President RC Tagum North, Rtn. Bebot Madayag, District Governor's Representative & PP of RC Tagum. Other Rotarians who helped in giving various information included Rtn. Arrel Olaňo, PP RC Tagum; Rtn. Danny Lee, Past DGR and PP of RC Tagum North; Rtn. Jun Cagas and Rtn. Raffy Erfe, both RC Tagum North.

Out of the original forty (40) ladies who were invited to organizational meetings, only 25 were finally submitted for charter membership of the new club. Agnes Resurreccion, Dir.; Rtn. Marilyn Grace Mangilet, Dir.; and Rtn. Arisfina Torre, Dir.

The club officers & members of the newly organized ROTARY CLUB OF TAGUM GOLDEN L.A.C.E.S. (Ladies in Action Committed to Effective Service) first met DG Xavier C. Ledesma, Incumbent District Governor for 1991-1992, at Molave Hotel on Sept. 4, 1992 in his club visitation of the Rotary Clubs in Tagum.

On December 1, 1992, the club received the good news from SEABO that its application for membership was formally admitted by Rotary International on November 19, 1992 with Club No. 29117.
