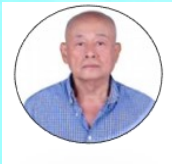

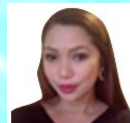

Supporting Frontline Workers in the Philippines

To help slow the spread of COVID-19 cases in the Greater Metro Manila area and Luzon archipelago, the Philippine government enforced a community quarantine on 16 March, 2020.

The exact numbers of healthcare workers, particularly doctors and nurses who have lost their lives while fulfilling their professional duties is still increasing in the Philippines. Exact data may not be accurate, but the fact remains that it may be higher than reported.

There are plenty of contributing factors to this, including patients not telling anyone about their recent travels in places where COVID-19 cases have been reported, exposure to people with the virus and vulnerability associated with existing medical conditions.

Furthermore, the lack of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is a global problem that we are facing here as well, and has added to the risks frontline workers face. The Executive Committee of District 3820, spearheaded by our current District Governor Everett Olivan, decided to utilize the district's entire calamity (disaster response) fund of \$37,000 USD. Each member has contributed \$3 USD every year for natural disasters such as typhoons and earthquakes but due to the urgency of the current situation, the funds were approved to support our community during this time.

With this money, we secured PPEs such as N95 masks, face shields and coverall suits. We coordinated with the Philippine Air Force to seek help in distributing these essential items to hospitals. The direct participation of our district members has never been encouraged to ensure everyone's safety, but countless members are passionate about being physically engaged in order to ensure frontline workers receive the protection they need.

I am a nurse by profession and work as a hospital care trainer. My spouse is an intensive care unit (ICU) nurse and we discussed the importance of one of us staying home to reduce the risk of exposure to COVID-19 and to be able to take care of our three-year-old child. Needless to say, I feel that if I can't be a frontline worker, then, I still want to be valuable to the community by serving as a catalyst to provide PPEs to our healthcare workers. In this little way, I am truly grateful and proud to be a Rotary member and a person of action.

I am truly humbled by the heroism of healthcare workers who are on the frontlines of this battle. Likewise, during this time, we have an opportunity as Rotary members to partner with our communities to lend a helping hand. As Rotary members, working hand in hand, together we will defeat COVID-19.

ROTARY CLUB OF TAGUM GOLDEN LACES HISTORY

The idea of organizing an all-female Rotary Club of Tagum was thought of as early as 1989 by the Rotarian and Anns of RC Tagum North. The initial organizing of the club however started only sometime in the first week of February 1991.

The names of 28 selected ladies were first floated by the Rotarians & Anns of RC Tagum North. Out of this number, 16 responded by attending the first organizational meeting held at Magnolia Kiosk along Quezon St., Tagum. Other ladies were later invited to the regular weekly meetings as prospective members of the club although their attendance along with some of those who were initially invited were irregular. In this organizational meetings, Rotary Information was given by Rtn. Jess Albacite, Special Governor's Representative and PP of RC Tagum North, Rtn. Rey Vegara, Incumbent President RC Tagum North, Rtn. Bebot Madayag, District Governor's Representative & PP of RC Tagum. Other Rotarians who helped in giving various information included Rtn. Arrel Olaño, PP RC Tagum; Rtn. Danny Lee, Past DGR and PP of RC Tagum North; Rtn. Jun Cagas and Rtn. Raffy Erfe, both RC Tagum North.

Out of the original forty (40) ladies who were invited to organizational meetings, only 25 were finally submitted for charter membership of the new club. The club officers & members of the newly organized ROTARY CLUB OF TAGUM GOLDEN L.A.C.E.S. (Ladies in Action Committed to Effective Service) first met DG Xavier C. Ledesma, Incumbent District Governor for 1991-1992, at Molave Hotel on Sept. 4, 1992 in his club visitation of the Rotary Clubs in Tagum.

On December 1, 1992, the club received the good news from SEABO that its application for membership was formally admitted by Rotary International on November 19, 1992 with Club No. 29117.
