RCC ADAP Village 15th Founding Anniversary 28 September 2019

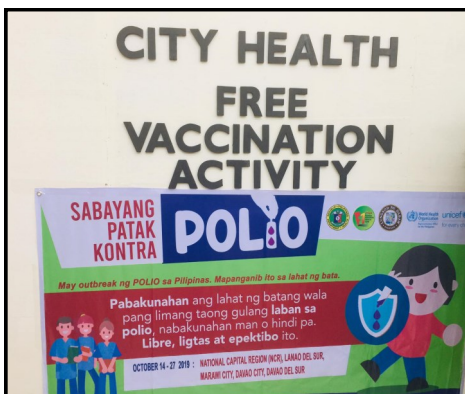
