RY 2023-2024 Search for the Most Outstanding Environmental Project

Rationale:

The Philippine Rotary Magazine/Media Foundation, Inc. supports the 7th Area of Focus on Environment of Rotary International by encouraging clubs to undertake projects to strengthen the conservation and protection of natural resources, advance environmental sustainability, and foster harmony between people and the environment.

Eligibility

- Award is open to all solely Rotary Club-Initiated Projects or projects implemented with significant partnership/engagement with NGOs/GOs.
- Any nominated project from the 10 districts must be operational for at least one (1) year at the time of the granting of the award on June 2024.

Mechanics

District Level: Each District will select their Most Outstanding Environmental Project. The District Governor will organize the nomination and judging process.

National Level: The top winning entry from each district will qualify for the national selection.
